PURPOSE: To provide Microbiologists to operate, maintain and perform sample analysis with laboratory instrumentation, tools and techniques on potential microbial or biological threat DNA samples in CONUS and/or OCONUS locations.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Create and design new methods to support expansion of laboratory capabilities and improve/solve existing method deficiencies
- Develop Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- Review, evaluate, and analyze data from samples and provide database entry support
- Expertise in emerging technologies for biological threat agent analysis
- Design, Lead, and oversee research and development and method development efforts
- Develop experimental designs and test plans
- Oversee the execution of test plans
- Train junior personnel on molecular biology and/or microbiology topics including sample collection/analysis/ threat-agent production
- Identify and research new and emerging technologies for biological threat agent analysis, and provide recommendations on platforms or instrumentation regarding their suitability for specific needs
- Expertise in current and emerging bioanalytical tools and techniques
- Analyze and interpret data
- Experience and expertise in using, maintaining, and troubleshooting the following types of equipment and instrumentation:
 - Next Generation Sequencers
 - Thermocyclers
 - Fluorescent-based detection systems
 - Robotic systems for sample preparation and extraction
- Supervise junior staff and assign daily tasks and responsibilities
- Ensure a proper chain of custody for all materials and samples is maintained
- Maintain a clean laboratory and personal workspace environment, in accordance with laboratory procedures
