



Get the skills you need for laboratory leadership

The Professional Science Masters (PSM) in Forensic Science program is designed to advance students' forensic science knowledge and provide the necessary administrative skills related to managing forensic organizations.

The program provides a cutting-edge curriculum with coursework in management designed to provide professional development opportunities. Twenty-four credits focus on technical forensic science content and 9 credits on professional business content, totaling 33 credits. Students progress through the program as a coordinated, scheduled cohort.

Ideal candidates are professionals with a life science degree, currently working in federal, state or private forensic organizations, medical examiner's offices, or law enforcement agencies looking to advance their career in forensic science management.

While graduates of forensic science programs tend to be prepared with scientific skills, they may lack the practical experience and critical thinking skills necessary to be ready to provide immediate support in the laboratory upon hiring.
